



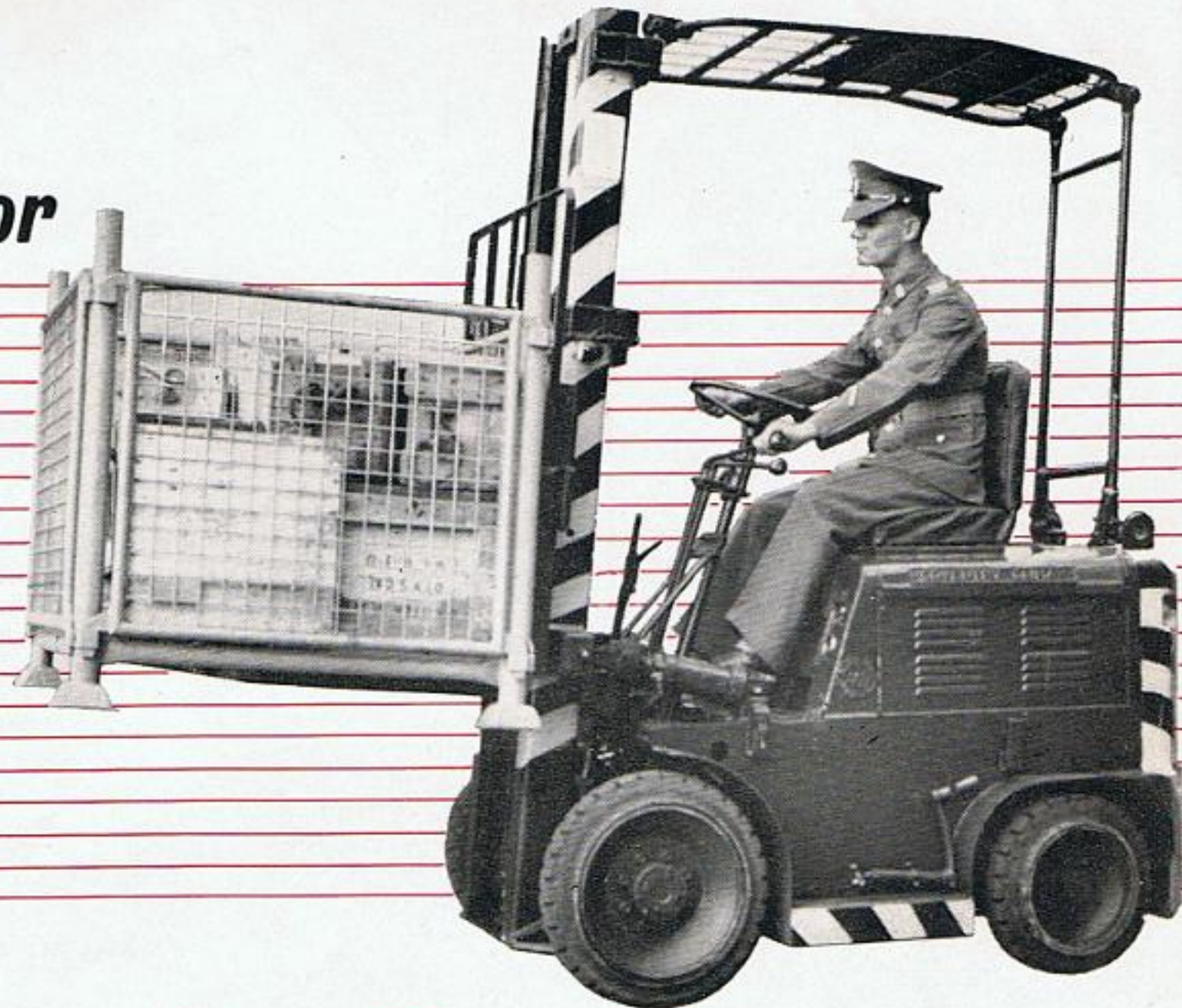

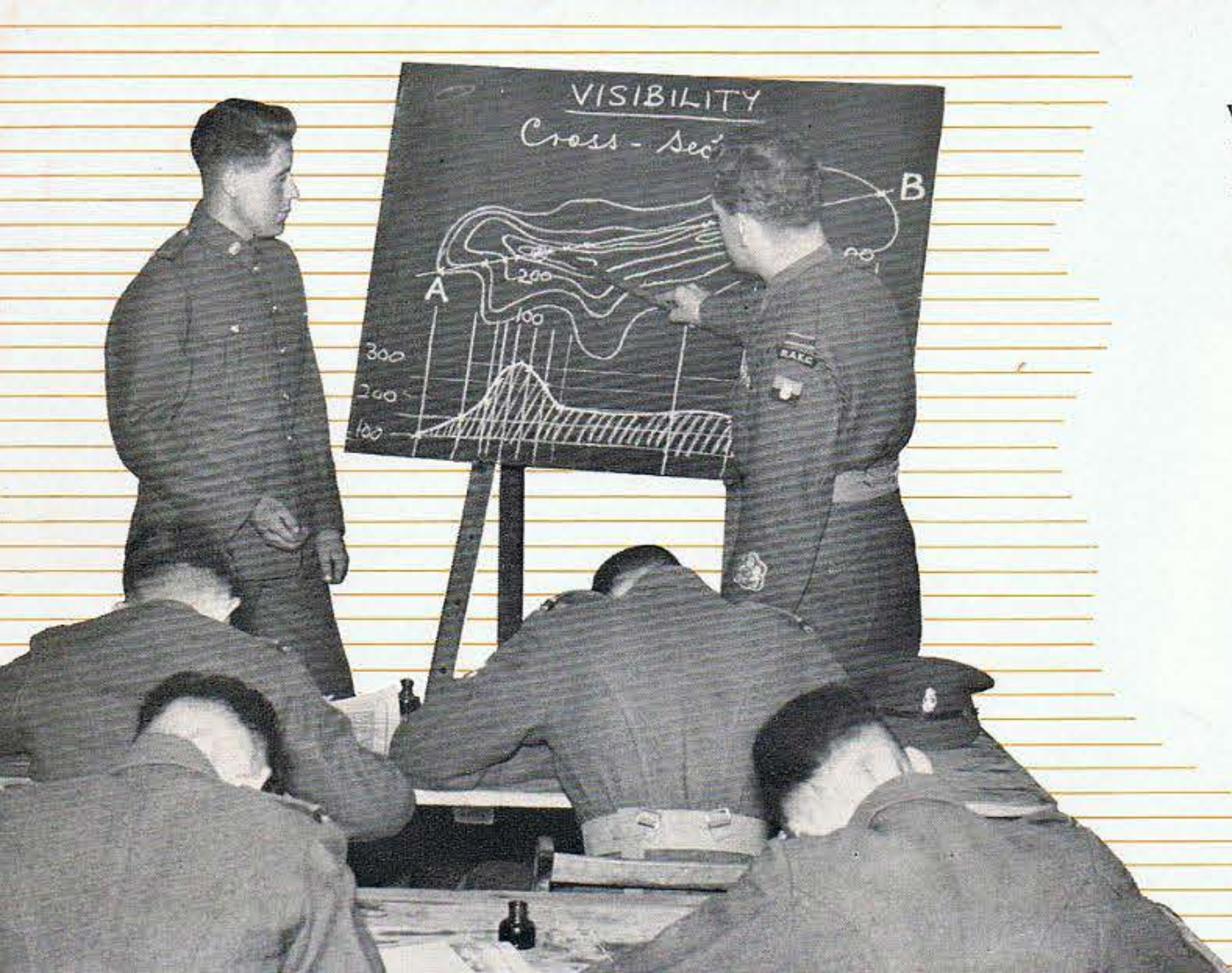

WOULD YOU like to see something of the world? Would you like to have a career with a future, and a future with a useful trade? Overseas stations in the R.A.O.C. in many parts of the world will give you the chance to travel far and wide.

The R.A.O.C. plays a most important role in the Army in that it provides the Army with its stores and equipment, including tanks, vehicles, motors, guns, machine guns, rifles and ammunition.

After enlisting you will go to the Junior Leaders' School at Blackdown, near Aldershot. Here not only will you do your normal military studies, but you will have the chance to train in the "Outward Bound Style". You will spend your time:

- (a) Playing games
- (b) Doing military training and administration
- (c) Hobbies.

During the 7 days' holiday in each year and at week-ends you can Youth Hostel, cycle, camp and climb. A fortnight's camp is held every year in the Isle of Wight prior to the summer holiday.

You can begin your career now in the Army as soon as you leave school by joining the R.A.O.C. Junior Leaders' Training School. You can enlist through any Recruiting Office.

What you can do if you become a Junior Leader in the R.A.O.C.

There are fine prospects for you and you can learn one of the following trades:

CLERK

PRINTER

TEXTILE REFITTER

SHOEMAKER

REGIMENTAL INSTRUCTOR

CINE PROJECTIONIST

TAILOR

STOREMAN

LAUNDRYMAN

DRIVER

AMMUNITION EXAMINER

All are useful trades and will stand you in good stead all your life.

The promotion prospects of an ex-Junior Leader in the R.A.O.C. are excellent and most ex-Junior Leaders become Sergeants within 2 years.

AGE AND SERVICE

You can join when you finish school up till you are 16½. You enlist to serve until you are 18 and then for 9 years with the Colours and 3 years in the Reserve.

HEALTH

You must be medically fit, at least 4' 7" and not less than 5st. 4lb. in weight.

PAY

Pay varies between 31s. 6d. and 66s. 6d. a week according to qualifications and length of service. Man's pay starts at 17½.

LEAVE

You get 70 days (with pay) each year. Each time you get a period of leave (at Christmas, Easter and Summer) you are provided with free rail travel to and from your home or leave address in the U.K.
