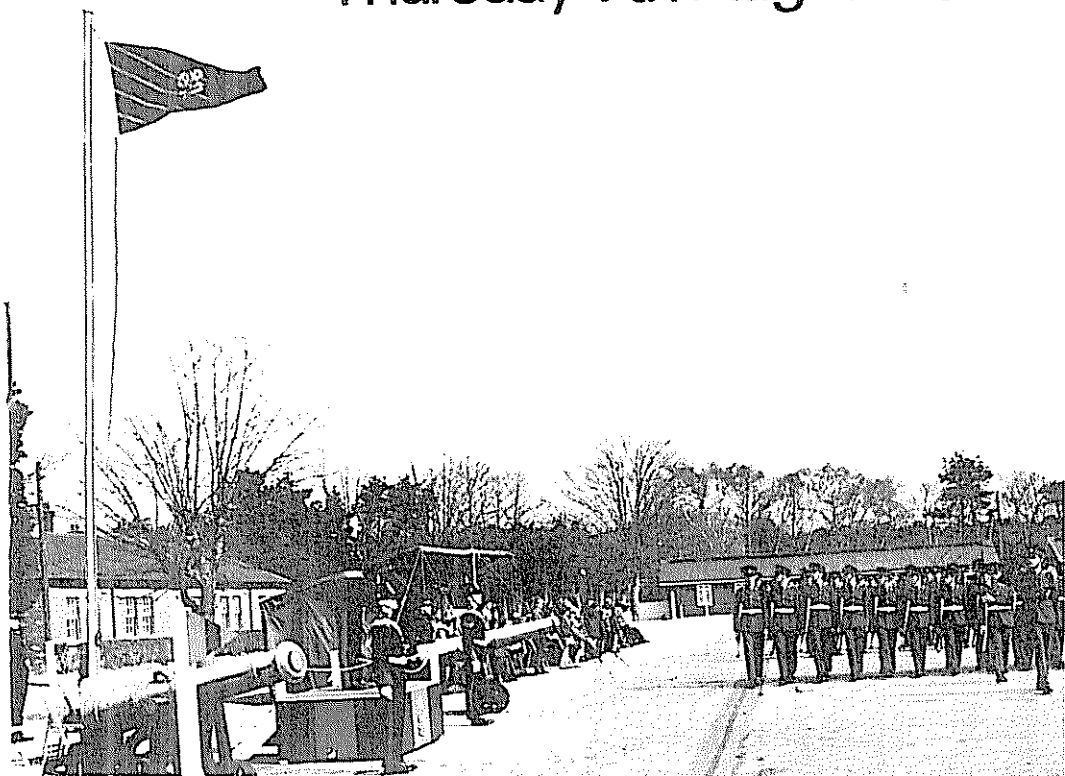

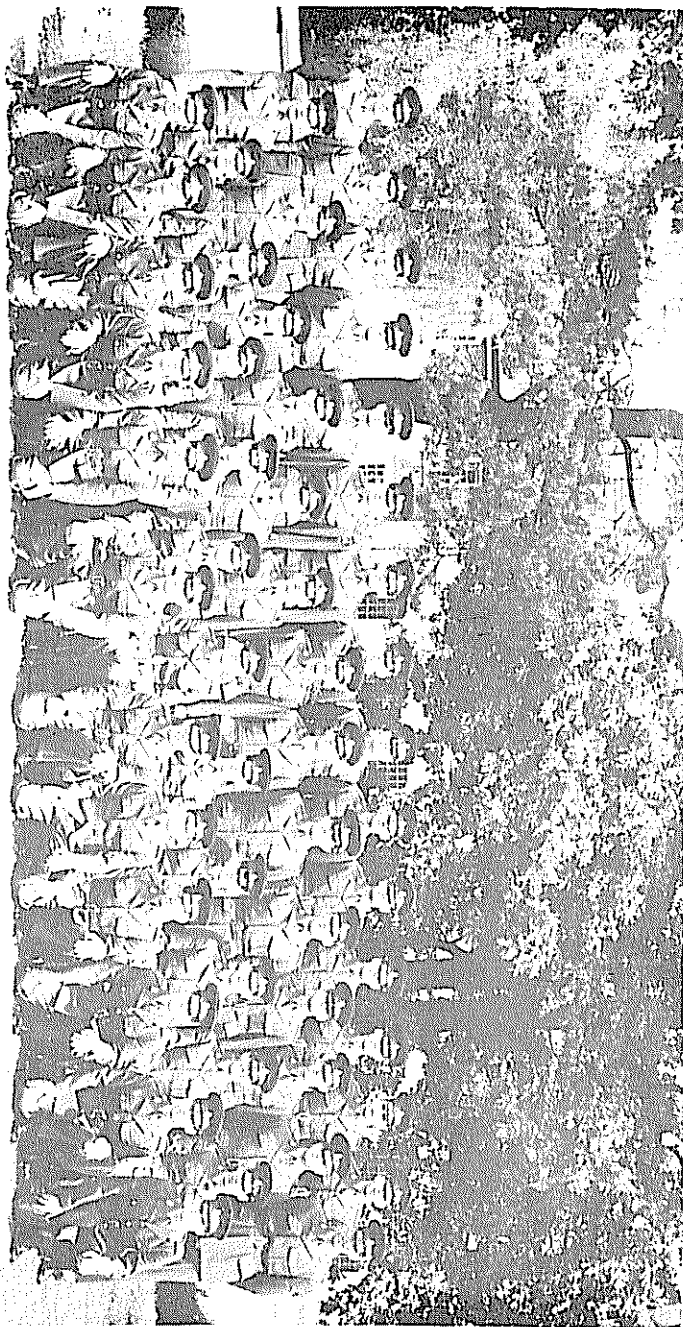

THE PASSING OUT PARADE

Major General A. YOUNG, Director of Ordnance Services, is today's Inspecting Officer.

Mrs YOUNG has very kindly consented to present the prizes and awards in the gymnasium after the parade.

The parade, in six platoons, is under the command of Junior Regimental Sergeant Major D.F. HAMPTON, and is drawn up as follows:

The RAOC Staff Band will play during the parade by kind permission of the Director of Ordnance Services, and Officers of the Royal Army Ordnance Corps.

At the conclusion of the parade, a display will be given by our Corps of Drums, under the command of Junior Drum Major J.A. GORDON-BAKER.

FORM OF PARADE

1. Display by the Corps of Drums.
2. The Battalion marches on to the Battalion Parade Ground and takes up dressing.
3. The Inspecting Officer, Major General A. YOUNG Director of Ordnance Services, arrives at the saluting base.
4. The Battalion presents arms and the Staff Band Plays the General Salute. (Spectators are requested to stand during the General Salute).
5. Junior RSM D.F. HAMPTON reports to the Inspecting Officer.
6. The Inspecting Officer inspects the parade.
7. The parade marches past by platoons in line, in slow time.
8. The parade marches past by platoons in line, in quick time.
9. General Salute. (Spectators are again requested to stand).
10. No 1 Platoon marches off in slow time.
11. No 2 Platoon marches off in slow time.
12. The remainder march off in column of route, in quick time.
13. The RAOC Staff Band marches off.
14. Display by the Battalion Corps of Drums.
