FORM OF PARADE

1. The Battalion marches on to the Battalion Parade Ground and takes up dressing.
2. The Inspecting Officer, Brigadier A.H. FARRAR-HOCKLEY, DSO, MBE, MC, arrives at the saluting base.
3. The Battalion presents arms and the band plays the General Salute. (Spectators are requested to stand during the General Salute).
4. Junior RSM D.J. LEITCH reports to the Inspecting Officer.
5. The Inspecting Officer inspects the parade.
6. The parade marches past by platoons in line, in quick time.
7. The parade advances in Review Order. (Spectators are requested to stand during the playing of the General Salute).
8. No 1 Platoon marches off in slow time.
9. The remainder march off in column of route, in quick time.
10. The RAOC Staff Band marches off.
11. Display by the Battalion Corps of Drums.
